2023 A Year of Expansion

In 2023, The One Ummah Foundation made strategic moves to double our endowment fund, and as a result, our program impacts exploded. We are proud of our efforts to create lasting effects in the world alongside our dedicated partner organizations, volunteers, and generous donors. This year, we provided for more children and families and responded to more disasters than ever!

In 2023, we continued partnerships with some of our long-term organizations, such as Sina clinics in Pakistan, which provides health care to just under a million of the poorest people in the region. We worked with HARO in Somalia to sponsor the continuous care of over 22 orphans and supported them to provide for hundreds more. We worked alongside the Heroic Hearts Organization to serve hot meals to tens of thousands in Gaza daily. We partnered with the Almuslimaath women's organization in Sri Lanka to support all children, regardless of background, in receiving a quality education. These are only a tiny handful of the fantastic partners we work alongside every day, and with your help, the impacts are growing daily, reaching some of the most untouched lives and supporting the neediest people worldwide!

Our impacts in 2023 are unmatched by previous years, indicating the strength of our partnerships and the importance of our financial sustainability model to carry us through even the most challenging times. Here are a few highlights of what we have accomplished together:

- Of our over \$2 million in expenses, 99% were expended on programs directly supporting those in need.
- We have partnered with over 35 organizations in 29 countries to carry out our impacts.
- Over ten million families and students received meals and food parcels.
- Over 300,000 at-risk children received support to be enrolled or stay in school. Without this support, most of these children would be used as forced labor.
- Established over 700 deep water wells in water deserts around the world.
- Responded to natural and man-made disasters in 7 countries

OUR MISSION

The One Ummah Foundation (OUF) aims to obliterate child labor globally by eliminating cycles of poverty, including ending hunger, illiteracy, and cashless economies, thereby reducing the family's need to rely on child income by supporting the entire family towards their full potential. The foundation's name means "One People" and embodies our commitment to uniting communities and helping children worldwide, regardless of their race, ethnicity, or religion. At One Ummah Foundation, we prioritize providing dignity and respect for everyone we serve.

The vision of the One Ummah Foundation is to eradicate child labor globally by creating greater education opportunities and reducing families' need to rely on their children as income earners, freeing them to attend school.

Programs supported by the One Ummah Foundation include school construction and operations support, child and orphan sponsorship, meals and food aid, disaster relief, medical care and clinic support, well building, water and sanitation provision, family support, refugee support, women's empowerment, elder care, care for people with disabilities, Ramadan support, and animal welfare.

OUR ORIGINS

After the tragic loss of his son, our Founder, Saeed Rahman brought to life the One Ummah Foundation in his honor. Since 1999, Saeed, alongside local and global volunteers, has relentlessly carried out the mission and vision of the organization with integrity and profound impacts. Since our inception, The One Ummah Foundation has provided for over 5 million children and their families in 33 countries. The organization has supported the construction of over 2,500 water wells, over 8 million meals, constructed more than 200 schools, and provided medical care to over 1 million.

Our Method

The One Ummah Foundation believes in the idea of pluralism. Central to this is the belief that we must help anyone in need, regardless of race, religion, ethnicity or any other social determinants. We provide humanitarian support by giving essential materials to enable children to access educational opportunities, establishing infrastructures that empower children to progress and thrive in their lives, assisting families in attaining self-sufficiency, and promoting their independence and resilience, and working towards stabilizing families and alleviating their suffering due to humanitarian crisis.

The One Ummah Foundation has prioritized enhancing educational infrastructure, recognizing it as a fundamental pillar for empowering children and improving the future.

Our partnerships are built with locally based organizations with a proven track record of providing quality direct services to those who most need them. We partner to develop the organization's capacity with a long-term strategy to improve and scale services. All partners must provide consistent reporting and audits when necessary to ensure financial integrity and provide the most services possible for the funds granted. We assure all donors that 100% of donated funds go directly to support those most in need, and the revenues of the organization's investments carry our administrative costs.

The One Ummah Foundation works in 29 countries and four continents with on-the-ground partners with a track record of providing services to those most in need.

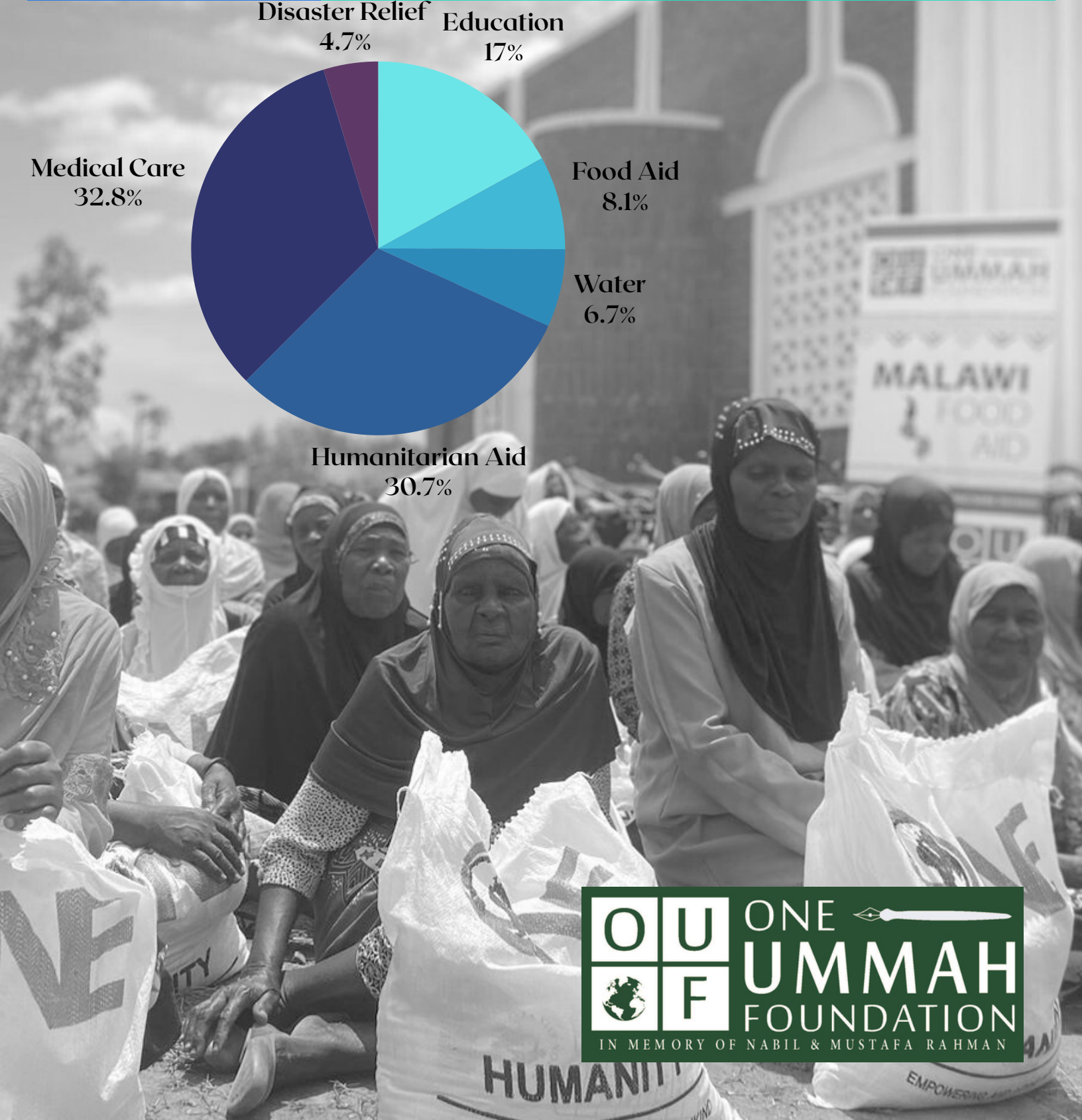
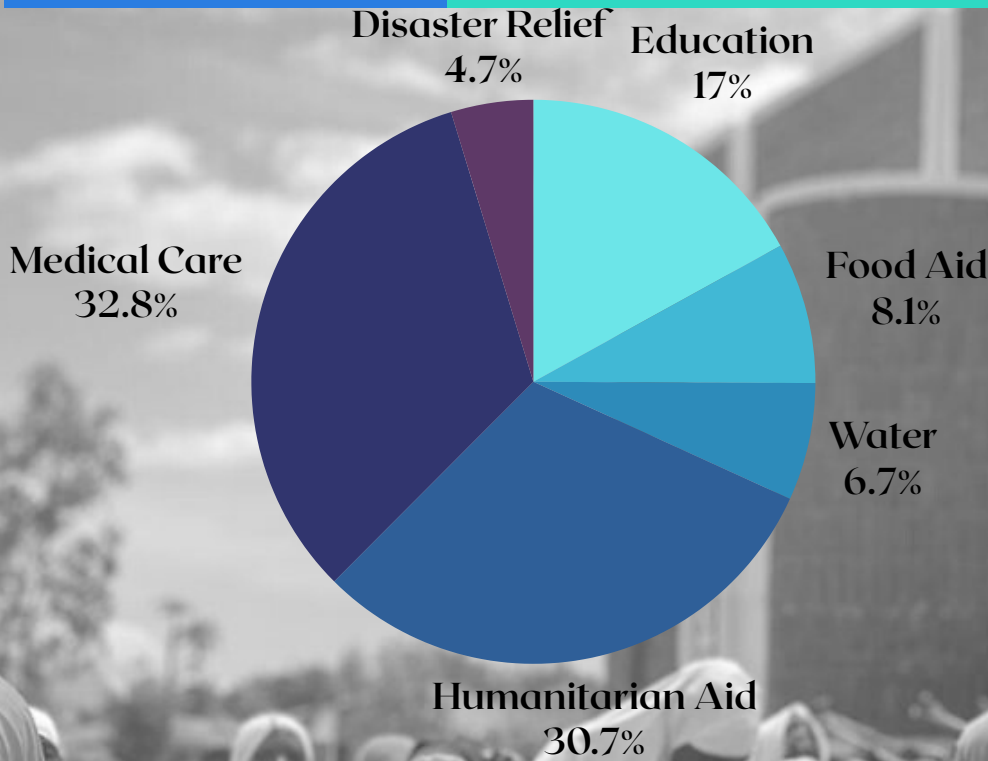

Children supported to go to school



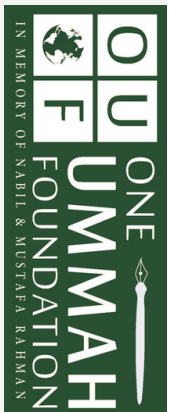

In 2024, The One Ummah Foundation aims to establish the following impacts with the help of our partner organizations and global volunteers.

1

Provide 15 million meals

In alignment with our strategic goal of providing 50 million meals by 2026, we aim to provide 1.5 million meals in 2024 and to continue to increase the number of meals every year. Meals are offered through worldwide soup kitchens, schools, as relief packages, and at mosques and churches.

2

Support a half million children with education

Children all over the world are at risk of forced labor and worse. They have dreams of becoming great people and making their families proud, but they need the proper education to realize their potential. In collaboration with incredible organizations worldwide, The One Ummah Foundation aims to support a half million children to get quality education in 2024. We will accomplish this goal by constructing and supporting schools, providing supplies and fees, and sponsoring orphans.

3

Construct 1,000 deep water wells

In many parts of the world, people must carry their daily water from long distances. Providing deep water wells all over water deserts in many parts of the world reduces the workload of primarily girls and women so that adults can work for income and children can receive education. The water improves sanitation and quality of life and provides a term source of pure water to the entire community.
